Scouting units should review the requirements; do the proper planning and turn their form in as soon as the unit completes the requirements. A special ribbon and certificate will be presented to the Scout unit at a roundtable or district event. Patches for their Scouts can be purchased to wear on their uniform showing their pride in being a BSA Green Unit.

-BSA Green Unit Award Requirements-

1. Unit volunteers undergo the Boy Scout "Leave No Trace" training. Unit agrees to follow the "Leave No Trace" practices.
2. Unit commits to do one community service project that relates to helping to clean up the environment.
3. Unit agrees to use biodegradable items or mess kits when camping or for outings.
4. Give leadership to one community education awareness presentation to another organization or adults.
5. All Scouts and adults in the unit agree to follow good environmental practices and be a good example for others to follow.
